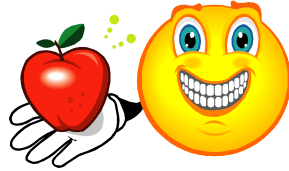

Yearbooks – It's not too late to order a yearbook. The cost is \$25/book. Please turn forms and money into the school office.

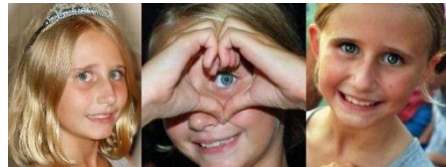
